To All Former ANCCR Presidents:

You automatically become an Honorary Life Member (better known as Life Member) when you are retired from the Cancer Registry Field and are 60 years of age. Both requirements must be met. Therefore, if you are retired and are not 60 years old, you must wait until you reach your 60th birthday before becoming a Life Member. If you have already reached your 60th birthday but are still working in the Cancer Registry field you must wait until you retire before becoming a Life Member. So, please remember that when you have met both requirements to contact the Membership Chair and let them know that you are eligible for Life Membership. Life Members are exempt from dues and retain their rights and privileges of the other Membership classes.

To All ANCCR Members:

Only former ANCCR Presidents are eligible for Life Membership. However, if any person makes a significant contribution to the profession of the Cancer Registry administration and/or practice or who has rendered distinguished service in the profession or it's related fields and has had his/her name recommended by the Executive Board, may be elected by the Active and Associate Members present, to Honorary continued on page 3
